Sight loss in Rutland




1 in 5 people are affected by sight loss. Vista manages the sight loss register for Leicester, Leicester and Rutland, meaning that anyone who is diagnosed with sight loss by a medical practitioner, is supported by Vista.

The chart opposite shows the number of people supported by Vista over the past year by location within Rutland.

Across such rural communities, adapting to sight loss can feel incredibly isolating

Last year over 137 people were referred to Vista's range of services in Rutland. Of these, 119 received rehabilitation support either following registration and/or diagnosis. This may have included adaptations to the home, provision of low vision aids such as magnifiers, white cane training, and support with re-learning independent living





Sarah's story

"I couldn't drive, couldn't' live alone. I couldn't even cook. When I tried to make a sandwich, I ended up cutting myself or falling over." Worst of all, she felt isolated. "My son lives in Brighton, but I couldn't get down to see him. I was stuck in my house not living."

"I was reluctant to get any help. I didn't accept that I needed it, or even know what help was available"

"It's opened my eyes, if you'll excuse the pun. It's all attitude, and Vista have really helped me realise I can do this. Life can get better, and I am the proof."

"You don't just have to live, but you can have a life. Vista have helped so much in getting my life back together."



By 2028 we will...

Raise awareness of preventing avoidable sight loss to 1000's of individuals including:

- Eye Screening for 4-5 years olds in primary schools
- Eye Screening Adults in employment
- Supporting those at risk of sight loss because of their condition (eg Glaucoma)
- Visual awareness training



By 2028 we will...

Deliver a broader range of peer led options supporting more people through the most difficult times including:

- Living well with sight loss support groups
- Community meet ups led by people with and affected by sight loss
- Focus groups encouraging co produced services
- Increased opportunities for peer to peer life learning – Tech support, 1:1 buddy, life hacks,
- Specific programme for transition for 18-25 yrs old
